Birthing tub at Rockyview General Hospital

A customized space to allow for both hospital and midwife supported birth, advancing options for birth plans and each parent's needs.

Central Fetal Monitoring throughout Calgary Zone

A province-wide monitoring system with more sophisticated surveillance to ensure a higher level of awareness and monitoring of moms and babies.

Care by Parent Room at South Health Campus

Learning to support newborns in home-like environments before leaving the NICU can be scary and this space allows for families to transition with overnight monitored care.

Perinatal mental health resources for rural moms

Support for rural community centres with the expertise of the postpartum mental health team to allow for early detection of symptoms and better support for moms.

Rockyview General Hospital NICU Nutrition Station

A dedicated space at Rockyview General Hospital's NICU for milk preparation. This is a critical component of newborn care in ensuring that the specialized nutrition needs of each newborn can be better supported.

NICU Advanced Equipment

With the evolution of technology, funding ensures that the best and most research informed equipment is available at all four of Calgary's NICUs to support each newborn's varying needs through their complex care journey.

Southern Alberta Neonatal Transport Services (SANTS)

Ensuring that each newborn receives the best care in the first minutes and hours of their lives, transferring them to the most appropriate care for their complex needs.
