Key accountabilities of the role include:

- **Volunteer engagement**, including the development and implementation of strategies to engage and connect volunteers to the Foundation.
- **Implementation of an annual volunteer engagement strategy**, aligned with the Foundation’s strategic plan.
- Work closely with the Director, Community Engagement & Donor Relations to **identify opportunities** for volunteers to engage with other stakeholders to expand our volunteer base
- **Develop and manage relationships with volunteers**, acting as a key point of contact, internally and externally, to further the mission, vision, and priorities of the Foundation.
- Work closely with People & Culture to **design and implement an onboarding process for volunteers** to enhance their overall experience.

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The ideal candidate has experience working with and supporting volunteers, implementing strategies to embed them in the Foundation's activities.
